The charity Open Doors highlights some startling statistics:

More than 380 million Christians suffer high levels of persecution and discrimination for their faith. Last year:

4,476 Christians were murdered 7,679 Churches and Christian properties were attacked 4,744 Christians were imprisoned

The top five worst countries are North Korea, Somalia, Yemen, Libya & Sudan.
