### Africa



**Violent Epicentre:** Nigeria is one of the most dangerous places to be a Christian, with thousands killed annually by Boko Haram, ISWAP, and Fulani militants.

**Displacement Crisis:** Roughly 16.2 million Christians are displaced across Nigeria and sub-Saharan Africa due to violence, equivalent to the populations of London, Birmingham, Manchester, and Liverpool combined.

**Rapid Spread:** Violence against Christians in sub-Saharan Africa has increased significantly, with radical Islamist ideology spreading from Nigeria to countries like Burkina Faso, Mali, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Mozambique.

**Rising Hostility:** In 2021, the number of Christians killed in sub-Saharan Africa rose by 270%, and in 2025, Sudan and other countries saw increased threats due to civil war & extremism.

**Pray:** for Christians in Sub-Saharan Africa facing severe, escalating violent persecution, particularly in Nigeria where many are killed for their faith. Ask for God's protection for believers, comfort for those traumatized by violence, and strength for church leaders in dangerous areas.
